"A" Enter at working trot rising
"X" Halt through walk
Salute and proceed at medium walk

"C" Track left at medium walk

3

"H" Working trot rising

4

"E" Circle left 20 meters, working trot rising
"E" Continue straight ahead in working trot

5

Between "K" & "A" Medium walk

6

F-X-H Free walk on loose rein
"H" Medium walk

7

"C" Working trot rising

8

"B" Circle right 20 metres, working trot rising
"B" Continue straight ahead in working trot

9

Between "F" & "A" Medium walk

10

"A" Turn down center line
"X" Halt. Salute

Collective Marks		Points
Gaits	(freedom and regularity)	10x2
Impulsion	(desire to move forward, elasticity of the steps, suppleness of the back, engagement of the hindquarters)	10x2
Submission	(attention and confidence, harmony, lightness and ease of movements, acceptance of the bridle, lightness of the forehand)	10x2
Rider	(position and seat, correctness and effect of the aids)	10x2
